



Uniform Policy and Dress Code

In summary of Columbia Christian Academy's Dress Code and Appearance Policy, your child's clothing should be modest, clean, well-fitting, and in good condition. His or her appearance should be a representation of the Lord, his/her family, and our school. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

POLOS: Long or short sleeved in any solid color except neon shades.

- NO logos except Columbia Christian Academy logo
- In 1st grade and above, shirts are tucked in.

PANTS: Solid-colored, chino-style pants in khaki/beige, navy or black only.

- Classic twill-type fabric only
- NO extra zippers, pockets, embellishments, or logos
- Loose fitting, straight leg, not skinny style

SHORTS/CAPRIS/SKIRTS: Same color, fabric and specifications as pants

- Shorts and skirts must be close to the knee.

DRESSES- POLO DRESSES & JUMPER DRESSES: Solid colored in beige, navy or black

- No logos or embellishments
- Must be close to the knee

LEGGINGS: Solid colored in white, beige, black, or navy

- Leggings are unacceptable as uniform pants.
- Leggings are to be worn under skirts and dresses only.

BELTS: Must be worn in 1st grade and higher if belt loops are present.

SHOES: Must be closed around toe and heel

SWEATERS/JACKETS INDOORS: Solid colored in white, beige, grey, navy, or black.

- Button-up or zippered only
- NO logos, writing or designs
- Hoods are allowed but must not be worn indoors.

FRIDAY UNIFORM: Columbia Christian Academy logo t-shirts/sweatshirts with jeans/denim shorts

- Jeans must be loose-fitting and free of holes
- Leggings are not acceptable.
- As an alternative to dressing out in Spirit attire, students must wear the full uniform.

P.E. Dress Code (4th Grade & Higher): Solid-colored t-shirt, solid shorts/sweats, and tennis shoes

- T-shirts must have sleeves, be opaque with NO writing or images
- NO leggings, spandex, tight-fitting clothes, short shorts, or zippers

Hair/Jewelry/Other: Hair, jewelry and nails must be of moderate style.

- Hair length must not impair vision.
- Any uncommon haircut or unnatural hair color will not be allowed.
- No new piercings or tattoos may be acquired while enrolled as a student.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- Jewelry and nails are to be of modest design with no gaudy extremes.
